


# **CALGARY**POPULATION

- Total population, as of April 1, 2024: 1.5 million persons
- Total annual population increase: 87,600 persons
- Fastest annual population growth among major cities

## City of Calgary: Population Growth

Calgary's population is projected to grow by 3.5 per cent in 2025 and 2.2 per cent in 2026. This is largely due to anticipated reductions in international immigration over the next few years.








# CALGARY LABOUR MARKET

- Highest unemployment rate among major CMAs
- Significant population growth among major cities
- Alleviated pressure in some sectors

#### **Unemployment Rate**



Calgary's sluggish economic growth has hindered its ability to accommodate the influx of job seekers due to rapid population growth, resulting in rising unemployment.







# CALGARY HOUSING MARKET

- Population growth sustained housing demand
- 2 Major increases in permits and housing starts
- 3 Shelter costs is a significant driver of inflation

#### **Benchmark House Price**

Benchmark price growth is expected to ease in 2025 amid slower population growth, improved supply, and weaker consumer confidence due to economic uncertainty.








## CALGARY INFLATION RATE

- Tariffs to impact construction expenses
- Rising input costs in manufacturing sector
- Removal of carbon tax to impact inflation



Calgary's CPI inflation is expected to remain above the Bank of Canada's inflation target in 2025, at 3.0 per cent.






