Duties and Responsibilities

- Act as an ambassador of Procurement at STEMCELL; represent Procurement in cross-functional meetings and projects; act as an advisor and subject matter expert for Procurement activities and ensure cross-functional stakeholder engagement in Procurement activities by facilitating a culture of collaboration and responsiveness.
- Makes recommendations for improvements on existing processes, identifies innovative solutions and leads improvement initiatives.
- Support optimization of purchasing processes through testing, documenting and implementation of ERP system improvements.
- Monitor KPI's and oversee order management activities to ensure on time delivery.
- Provide procurement expertise and training to team members as required.
- Manage all aspects of purchases from requisition to delivery, for both direct and Indirect materials; issuing Purchase Orders, setting delivery schedules, monitoring status of outstanding POs and deliveries, expediting when necessary, assisting with issues related to invoicing and/or delivery issues and follow-up on returns or refunds for non-conforming materials.
- Maintain data integrity in ERP system.
- Develop and maintain supplier relationships, acting as an interface between suppliers and internal stakeholders.
- Monitor and advise on any areas of supply risk (demand, supply, environmental and business continuity) and work with internal stakeholders to implement risk management strategies.
- Obtain price quotes and validate pricing with suppliers. Contribute to team cost savings goals and document cost savings when appropriate.
