- Strategically plan and manage logistics, warehouse, and transportation
- Overseeing the management of all warehouse operations
- Supervising the quality, quantity efficiency of storage and movement of goods
- Prioritize shipments and work tasks for warehouse staff
- Manage logistics network and work with 3rd party providers to ensure on time delivery (inbound & outbound)
- Maintain ongoing cross-border trade compliance with USA by working with internal/external stakeholders (vendors, customs brokers, carriers, and Customer Service teams)
- Analyze logistical challenges, developing and new solutions to efficiently meet business growth efficiently
- Maintain good relationships with carriers while holding them accountable
- Negotiating rates with carriers to maximize profitability
- Carrier management, evaluation, development, and market knowledge as it relates to performance, safety, rate negotiations
- Initiate freight claims and determine root cause when necessary

- Drive strategic sourcing of ingredients and alternate supplier identification
- Develop hedging strategy on key commodities
- Manage, coach, and develop the supply chain team to set and execute company objectives
- Support implementation and proper utilization of ERP system (SAP)
- Other duties as assigned by the Operations Manager or the Company
