DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair of Applied Commerce and Management Education, the Instructor will be responsible to teach primarily Logistics and Supply Chain Management related courses. These courses may include, but are not limited to, Project Management, Introduction to Supply Chain Management, Logistics Processes, Procurement and Supply Management, Integrated Logistics and Supply Chain Strategy. These courses may be delivered online and/or in-class at the Notre Dame Campus. Duties will include the preparation of course materials and assessments, instruction of students and evaluation of assessments. Duties related to instructing include: curriculum development and maintenance, preparing course outlines, maintaining student records, student evaluation, assisting in college activities including student orientation, graduation, and relevant committees.
