Responsibilities

As the Clinical Sourcing Manager, you are responsible for the sourcing functions related to FF&E Apply Now (https://jobs.careerbeacon.com/apply/1714902?utm_source=careerbeacon) acquisitions within the Clinical TIR Supply Chain team. These acquisitions will focus on healthcare

infrastructure projects, all of which are characterized as aving significant complexity and risk.

You will oversee business requirements and deliverables associated with the FF&E acquisition process, including project management, scheduling, risk management, change management, process evaluation, as well as implementing solutions and applying lessons learned. You are comfortable working with GPO's (Group Purchasing Organizations) and understand the importance of leveraging their full potential.

You will support the development of key performance indicators that reflect appropriate allocation of financial and human resources as they apply to program delivery, all the while seeking efficiencies, cost savings, and continuous improvement.
