THE OPPORTUNITY:

Reporting to the Manager - Commodity Procurement, the Senior Buyer is responsible to meet the procurement needs of the organization by efficiently and effectively requesting quotes, negotiating prices, sourcing & procuring the designated components group, other items and associated services. This position also aligns to assigned Product/Engineering functions for new business awards and the APQP process liaison.

The position requires a minimum amount of supervision with a clear understanding of all Procurement principles and activities along with maintaining high ethical standards, awards and the APQP process.

While this opportunity is located at our Head Office in North York, Ontario, Canada, the position location is open to other areas at ABC Technologies.

WHAT YOU WILL DO:

- Responsible for development with senior management and implementation of the commodity strategy.
- Responsible for developing in-depth understanding key commodity drivers: cost, markets, competition, global supply landscape, supply-demand constraints etc.
- Leads the development and commercial roadmap for the commodity that supports overall
 procurement strategy, sales/new business development strategy and most importantly financial
 performance of the company.
- Independent responsibility for cost management of the given commodity; develops RFI/RFQs, conducts market tests and leads supplier negotiations to establish and maintain cost competitiveness.
- Evaluates global supplier landscape that supports LCC/BCC sourcing strategies; Manages supply base though prospecting and qualifying new suppliers, proposing supplier consolidation, re-sourcing and low-cost-country options.
- Champions and leads cross-functional teams to drive VA/VE activities that support cost competitiveness.
- Develops yearly business plans that support fiscal financial planning/budgeting process.
- Conducts commodity portfolio reviews to communicate and establish strategic alignment with key stakeholders.
- Establishes clear alignment between commercial and technical roadmap towards the development of a strategic supplier framework.
- Reviews Capital Appropriation requests within the designated commodity area i.e. tooling for the commodity to be purchased.
- Maintains up-to-date supplier files, including communication schedule with key suppliers, and bring forward system for contracts and related correspondence.
- Performs annual review of all service contracts.

- Ensures Policies and Procedures are properly administrated in accordance with existing Policy.
- Maintains familiarity with the Group Procurement function and all the related functional areas (Sales, Product Development, Operations, Quality).
- Serve as point of contact for the BU and required Buyer which will drive sourcing of specified components.

- 5-10 years of procurement/commodity management experience in a manufacturing environment.
- 5 years min of automotive experience.
- University Degree/Diploma in a business, engineering or finance.
- Deep understanding of specific components and its cost drivers.

- Understanding of internal and external factors (cost, pricing, margins, profit impact of decisions), and market dynamics.
- Strong analytical skills sets, including cost modeling, indexing, pricing.
- Candidate must be able and committed to staying up-to-date with business and technological developments, and contribute to continuous improvements.
- Ability to organize and analyze large amounts of data.
- Must be able to travel to different locations and attend to work issues where and when they occur.
- Good understanding of Quality, Inventory and Logistics.
- Demonstrated negotiation experience and strong negotiations skills sets. (communication, assertiveness, results-oriented, persuasive).
