The Procurement & Planning Manager is accountable to the Supply Chain Director for the procurement, planning functions as well as associated master data at Septodont Cambridge. The scope of this position includes leadership and oversight of all aspects of purchasing, short and long range planning, and production resource scheduling. The scope of responsibility includes all third party or affiliate company produced dental products sold in the Canadian market as well as dental anesthetics and pharmaceuticals made at the Cambridge facility.

Key responsibilities include:

- Lead purchasing and planning groups and oversee daily operations of the procurement and planning functions and serve as the hands-on leader that understands and performs the daily tactical and strategic functions
- Contributing to the planning and execution of the overall supply chain strategy
- Proactively identify key risks to future supply chain needs and propose and drive the necessary changes to address them.
- Establish and execute a monthly supply plan and an inventory management strategy for anesthetics and pharmaceuticals to balance the manufacturing capacity with customer demand, inventory targets, and project timelines.
- Establish and execute a monthly procurement plan and inventory management strategy for purchased products including pain control, materials, therapeutics and operating supplies.
- Support the Septodont global purchasing committee process including forecasting, planning, inventory management and supplier management.
- Negotiate supply agreements, contracts and terms as well as build these skills amongst team members.
- Work closely with various business functions to ensure proper selection, evaluation and acquisition of all materials while also mitigating critical situations as they arise with the supplier base.
- Manage an efficient flow of goods to ensure optimum production.
