Main Qualifications & Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with appropriate teams to help develop a plan to manage flow through the pipeline.
- Understand ABC classification of components and use this to deploy effective treatment of these parts.
- Aggressively attack Safety Stock and Lot Sizing through careful calculation and exposing part commonality.
- Reduce E&O through timely reporting, customer collection and cadence and pursuing opportunities for change.
- Inventory Reporting / Data Analytics / Financial year end / Physical Counts and Reporting.
- Co-create and oversee high visibility of inventory through various tools such as; Kan Ban, 2 Bin, Visual Reorder point
- Redesign Cycle Count program in order to identify root cause of inventory loss and proper corrective actions.
- Eliminate waste in processes through reduced move times and unnecessary transactions – DFSDC
- Evaluate scrap/yield factors on BOM's against historical data and effect changes in BOM to reflect reality
- Developing and maintaining Factory Inventory Footprints.
- Develop internal milk routes for optimal material delivery to and from assembly.
- Ensure all stock discrepancies are followed up, fixed, and recorded.
- Assist in the development and implementation of projects for improvement of all things "inventory" related.
- Develop accurate, consistent, and enhancements to the inventory reporting structure.
- Work in tandem with the SCM org to maintain flexible attitude supporting all stated objectives.
