#### **Job Responsibilities**

- Prioritizes and ensures execution of daily distribution activities according to the urgency, volume, and available resources to meet and/or exceed service level agreement; ensures exceptions are responded to as per escalation procedure.
- Supervises daily floor performance and creates a positive and engaged team environment
- Facilitates employees' competency development, one on one meeting, via on-boarding programs, recruitment activities, regular rotational assignments, structured training, assessments, individual coaching and delegation, etc.

- Use systems and metrics to guide the initiation and execution of safety, quality, productivity and continuous improvement initiatives in support of the Operational Business Objectives Ensures warehouse systems and equipment are being maintained properly and coordinates repair and improvement with appropriate resources.
- Enforce distribution compliance, from both a safety, SOP and a GMP perspective, at all stages of material handling (regular, controlled, and waste)
- Facilitates cross-functional communications with all key stakeholders. (supply chain, production, packaging, sales, customer service, traffic, quality, as well as external suppliers and contractors).

- Minimum five years of logistics/warehouse/distribution experience with accountabilities in a leadership role, ideally in a pharmaceutical or food manufacturing industry.
- A post-secondary diploma or degree in logistics management, supply chain management, and / or other related fields; equivalent working experience considered.
- Demonstrated in-depth knowledge and application of GMPs, safety, and logistics management as well as planning experience would be an asset.
- SAP experience would be preferred.
- Proven successes in motivating, coaching, problem-solving, decision-making, prioritizing and achieving results through others.
- Demonstrated service-oriented attitude and results with strong analytical thinking
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Exhibited capacity in building consensus with cross-functional personnel
- Ability to work under pressure in a fast-paced environment.
