- High degree of confidence in negotiation of both commercial and legal contractual terms is an asset.
- You have certificates in procurement, supply management, inventory management, Lean/Six Sigma, or operational planning. A MBA/Master's degree in Business, Supply Chain Management, Finance, or Operations Management is an asset.
