YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

This position is responsible to review Purchase Requisitions, obtain quotes, prepare bid comparisons, negotiate and issue purchase orders.

The successful candidate will:

- Process orders in SAP (MM) which may include ad hoc requisitions, outline agreements, purchases from material number info records, and source lists.
- Prioritizes work based on criticality and time-based requirements.
- Bundle purchasing needs to support standardized buying activities that can lead to economies of scale, based on the direction of the Senior Procurement Specialist.
- Purchasing and scheduling of materials, raw materials, spares and operating supplies as well as services.
- Document supplier performance including corrective action for suppliers as required and follow up on improvement needs.
- Manage risks and opportunities related to the portfolio and work through escalated issues with suppliers as necessary.
- Manage assigned purchase requirements using a risk based approach.
- Work proactively to meet strategic targets for cost savings.
- Analyze vendor capabilities versus requirements and research new suppliers.
- Evaluate existing suppliers based on price, quality, selection, service, support, availability, reliability and supplier's track record.



- Work with procurement colleagues to ensure a consistent standard for vendor evaluation and negotiations.
- Negotiate, or renegotiate with suppliers or vendors.
- Consult with departments across KSPC to understand technical specifications and product requirements.
- Review product specifications, maintaining a working technical knowledge of the goods or services to be purchased, as determined by the Senior Procurement Specialist.
- Oversee day to day supplier management and adhering to spend budgets.
- Develop and recommend improvement ideas to the Senior Procurement Specialist regarding procurement policies and procedures.
- Train end users on procurement processes, as necessary.
