- Contribute to SAP support pack implementation through test script development, execution, and peer training
- Taking ownership of supply chain tools and their development and continuous improvement
- Experience with e-procurement platforms, online catalogue systems, and SAP integration with digital tools
- Enable integration and analysis using tools such as SAP Signavio, Robotic Process Automations and GIB to enhance supply chain system performance
- Ensure supply chain compliance by developing and maintaining governance frameworks, standardized processes, and robust internal controls
